

Go With The Flow

Favorite Goods presents Go With The Flow, a group exhibition with works by **Anne De Vries**, **Spencer Longo**, **Micah Schippa**, **Travess Smalley**, and **Kate Steciw**.

This exhibition brings together the work of five artists working in New York, Los Angeles, Chicago and Amsterdam using various methods to twist and abstract the ideological associations of common day images and objects. Through the use of technological means of production these artists are exploring the infinite zone between virtual and reality, often blurring the two into a hazy hybrid.

Anne De Vries (b. 1977, Netherlands) Currently works in Amsterdam. De Vries has recently was included in a group exhibition at Palais de Tokyo, Paris, and has also shown at Ghoete-Institut, Rotterdam, LuckyPDF/Frieze, London, Cleopatra's, Berlin, and The Armory Show, New York. He was an artist in residence at the Rijksakademie, 2011/12, and studied at Gerrit Rietveld Academy, Amsterdam.

Spencer Longo (b.1986, New Hampshire) Lives and works in Los Angeles, CA. He is a contributing member to The Jogging (thejogging.tumblr.com), performed at VIA Music & New Media Festival, Pittsburgh, PA, in 2011 and has exhibited at Space Gallery, Pittsburgh, and Synchronicity Space, Los Angeles. Upcoming exhibitions include an exhibition of The Jogging at Godine Gallery, Boston.

Micah Schippa (b.1988, Michigan) graduated from The School of the Art Institute of Chicago in 2011, and lives and works in Chicago, IL. He is part of the collaborative group no-new.info and was a contributor to the website paintfx.biz. Schippa's work has been exhibited at MoMA PS1, New York, Museum of Contemporary Art, Chicago, Extra Extra, Philadelphia, and was included in the show Post Internet Survival Guide at Gentili April, Berlin.

Travess Smalley (b.1986, West Virginia) is based in New York City and received his BFA from The Cooper Union in 2010. He recently had a solo exhibitions at Envoy Enterprises, New York, and been included in group shows at Preteen Gallery, Mexico City, Foxy Production, New York, Bodega, Philadelphia, as well as galleries in Milan, Paris, Berlin, Hong Kong, and London.

Kate Steciw (b. 1979, Pennsylvania) lives and works in New York. Her works has been included in group shows at Toomer Labzda, New York, STADIUM, New York, Future Gallery, Berlin, as well as solo exhibitions at Primary Photographic Gallery, New York and The Composing Rooms, London. Steciw received a BA in Sociology from Smith College and an MFA from the School of the Art Institute of Chicago.
